On Wednesday September 16, 2009, Alert-O-Lite had an Addco DH-1000 Changeable Message Sign at a work site at Road 33 and Avenue 9, in the County of Madera. On Saturday September 19, 2009, employees went to the job site to change the sign message and it was discovered missing. The Theft has been reported to Madera County Sheriffs Department and assigned a case number of 09-4331. Deputy Patrick Davis is handling the case to its conclusion. The DH1000 is estimated value is \$20,000.00.
