



Stolen Equipment Alert

Alabama Tracked Skid Steer Theft 6.9.2010

Law Enforcement reports the below machine was stolen sometime June 8-9, 2010 from a location along CR65-S in rural Perry County Uniontown, Alabama where it was left after completing work in the area. The brush cutter/mulcher attachment on this machine is somewhat unique, and would make the machine distinguishable from similar models.

Someone potentially witnessed this machine being driven or loaded at the scene, or transported in the general area; please forward this alert to field staff and patrol personnel in the area.
