



# Stolen Equipment Alert

## Arkansas Tractor Theft 6.11.2010

Overnight June 10-11, 2010 thieves broke into the yard at a Clarksville, Arkansas dealership by cutting the lock off a gate on the pipe fence surrounding stored tractors. They then removed the below pictured new tractor and loaded onto their trailer to remove the machine from the site.
