



Equipment Fraud Alert

Rental Fraud, California

An NER member rental fleet reports that customer Richard Peterson, Lamont, CA, rented the below described Bobcat and a trailer in July, 2009 on a short term rental. At the expiration of the rental, Peterson failed to return the equipment, and now cannot be contacted. There is no construction activity at the jobsite address Peterson provided.

Similar to other offenders, the subject apparently provided what appears to be a valid State Identification including his real name.
