Transport and Skid Steer Theft, Atlanta

Saturday September 12, 2009, thieves broke into Sunbelt Rental's Midtown Atlanta branch, 1450 Howell Mill Road, where they loaded the two described skid steers onto the below Sunbelt roll-back truck, and stole all three units. The rig was seen traveling through Knoxville, TN Sunday September 13 with the machines.
