



Stolen Equipment Alert

Virginia Tracked Skid Steer Theft 6.10.2010

The below described machine was stolen from an open roadside job site near Shreve Road and the I-495 Beltway, Fairfax, Virginia sometime before the theft discovery June 10, 2010.

With increased theft activity in the Southeast, rental companies and contractors should put extra emphasis on securing machines that must be left on open sites, particularly those adjoining roadways that provide thieves ample access and exit routes.

Someone potentially witnessed this machine being loaded at the site, or transported in the general area; please forward this alert to field staff and patrol personnel in the area.
