



Stolen Equipment Alert

California Light Tower Theft 10.7.2009

An NER member rental company lost the below described machine to theft from a CalTrans SR-52 improvement project at SR-125 freeway in San Diego. The victim reports 500 gallons of diesel were also taken from the job site when the light tower was stolen. Theft occurred overnight October 6 to October 7, 2009.
