



## Stolen Equipment Alert

### Massive Paving Machine Theft, Florida

On August 1, 2009, thieves stole the below described Paving Machine from a road construction project at SR-7/441 in Boca Raton, Florida. This 500 horsepower machine weighs nearly 60,000 lbs, stands 15 feet tall and nearly 50 feet long when in operation. It takes several hours to configure the machine for transport or shipping.

Witnesses may have seen the machine being towed or loaded near the scene, or may have encountered it in transit anywhere in the region. There are a limited number of these machines, particularly this new, in the United States.
