



Stolen Equipment Alert

Arkansas Truck and Skid Steer Theft

NER Member fleet Hertz Equipment Rental reports the below machine and truck were stolen during a burglary at their Little Rock, AR branch September 1, 2009. Thieves were unable to load the machine on a Hertz trailer, but were so driven to steal the machine that they loaded it into the bed of a Hertz F-450 stake bed truck. The 8,000 lbs Bobcat severely damaged the bed, the lift gate was nearly ripped off from loading and unloading the machine, and the cab and headache rack were crushed from the loader and bucket resting on them.

The truck was later discovered abandoned on I-30 near Mount Pleasant, Texas.

This significantly overloaded truck should have stood out to anyone that observed it. NER strongly encourages everyone in the industry that sees such an obviously suspicious load to contact local Law Enforcement-**Dial 911**. Wouldn't you want someone to call if it was your machine and truck?
